# Future intention: Be Going to

- Am/is/are + going + to infinitive

- Usage:

To express future intention, decision or plan before the moment of speaking

I am going study hard

She is going to make a big meal

- Something is certain to happen

Look at the sky! It is going to rain

Watch out! The box is going to fall

# Like doing and would like to do

- Like doing or love doing express the general enjoyment.

I like reading books. (It is my hobby)

I like working as a teacher. (I am a teacher and I enjoy it)

- Would like to do or would love to do = want to do express a preference now or at the specific time

I would like to be a teacher = when I grow up, I want to be a teacher

Thanks, I'd love to dance = at the party, I am pleased you asked me.

outside every  
day.

*Verb + to + infinitive*

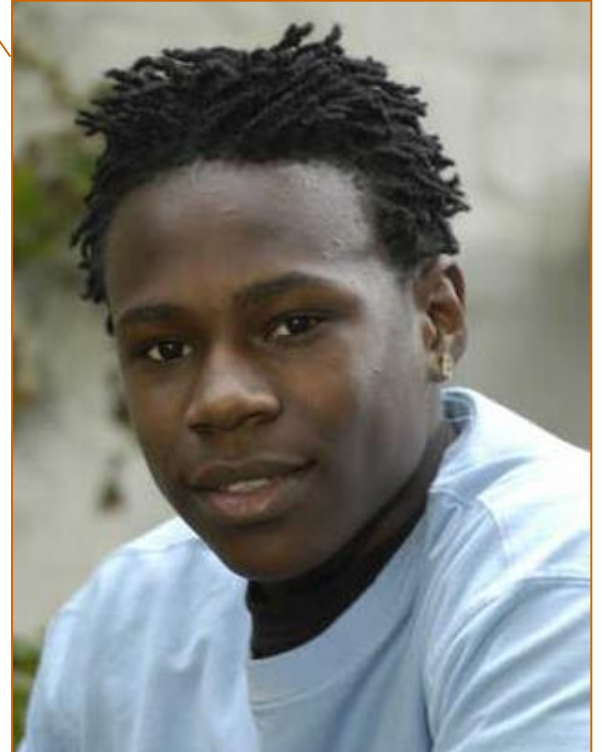
I'd like to be as tall as a giraffe.

Being short might be nice.



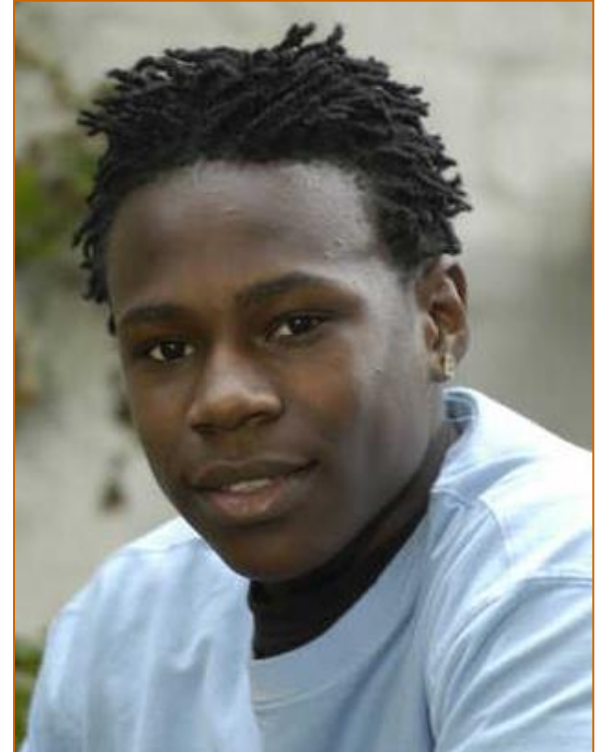
I'm **thinking of**

*Verb + preposition + ing*



I **started** **applying**  
to schools all over  
the U.S.

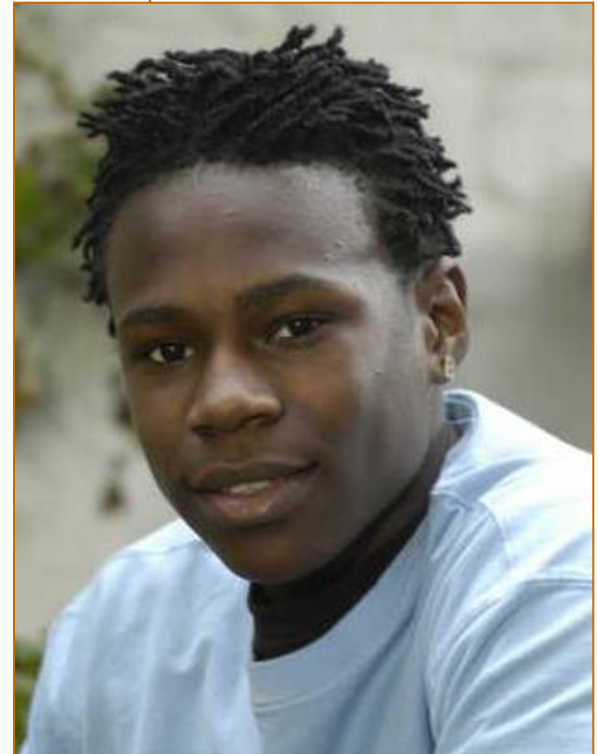
*verb + ing*





I **started** **to** **apply**  
to medical schools  
a few weeks ago.

*verb + to + infinitive*



**I started applying** to medical schools a few weeks ago.



**same meaning**

**I started to apply** to medical schools a few weeks ago.

I'd like to go to a basketball game this weekend.

specific time preference

I like going to basketball games.

general enjoyment

intention made **at** the moment of speaking



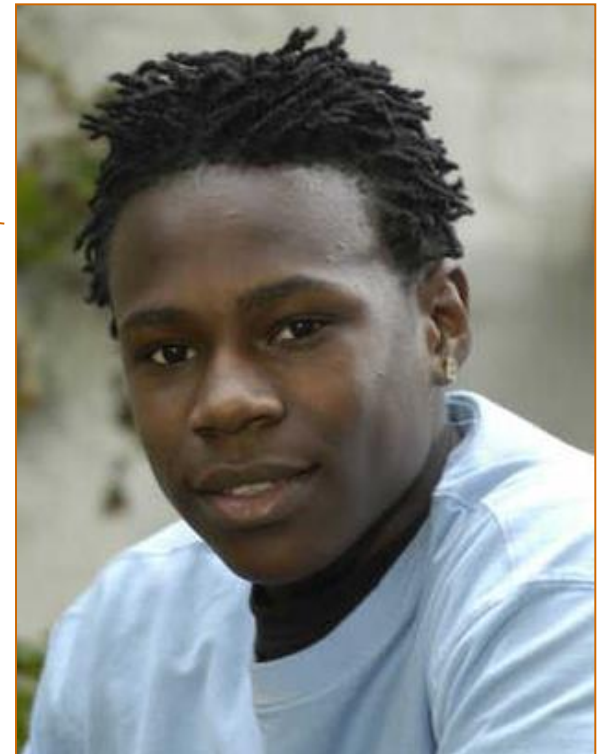
